Montgomery County has also now improved its process to make online appointments for COVID-19 tests for residents at MoCoCOVIDTesting.org. Appointments are encouraged to cut down on wait times, but walkups also are available at testing sites. County sites are in Germantown, Wheaton and White Oak and there are additional pop-up locations as well. Appointments can also be made by calling the Testing Helpline at 240-777-1755.

Of note, the Maryland Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) and the MD Community of Practice for Supporting Families is hosting its next webinar this coming Wednesday at noon.
