How to Use Zoom

Log on early to the web address via any computer, tablet or smart phone to address any glitches before the program start time.

1. From your tablet, smart phone or computer ***with a camera, microphone and speakers*** go to the web page listed above. See how they are different for both Jubilee Radio and Spirit Club's Biggest Winner.

2. If you have not used Zoom before you will be prompted to download and run the Zoom software. A .zip file will download and you will have to follow prompts to download the launcher.

3. (If you have used zoom from that device) You will be prompted on how to join the audio portion of the conference. Here you can select your preference- join by computer audio (recommended) or join by phone (better for some, particularly if you don't have a mic or speakers on your computer)

4. After you are in the "room" you will see a mic icon and (if you have a camera) a video icon appear at the bottom of your screen in a black bar.

5. If there is red hash mark over either (like /) then you are "muted" or the camera is not being accessed.
